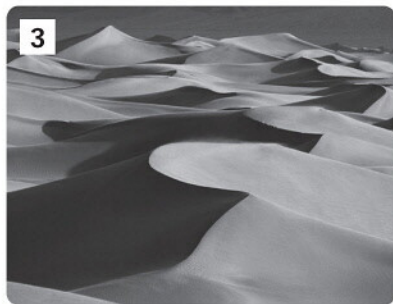
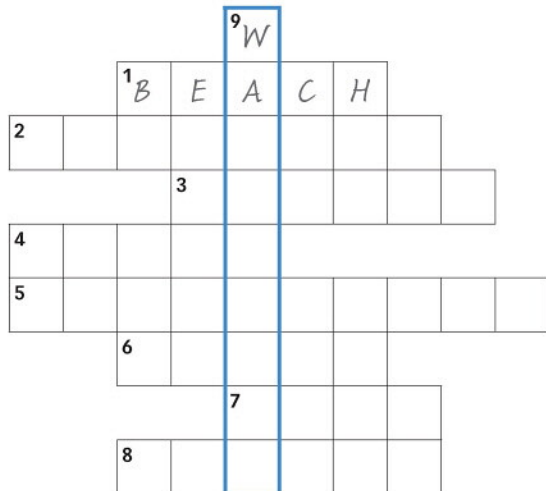

Hawaii

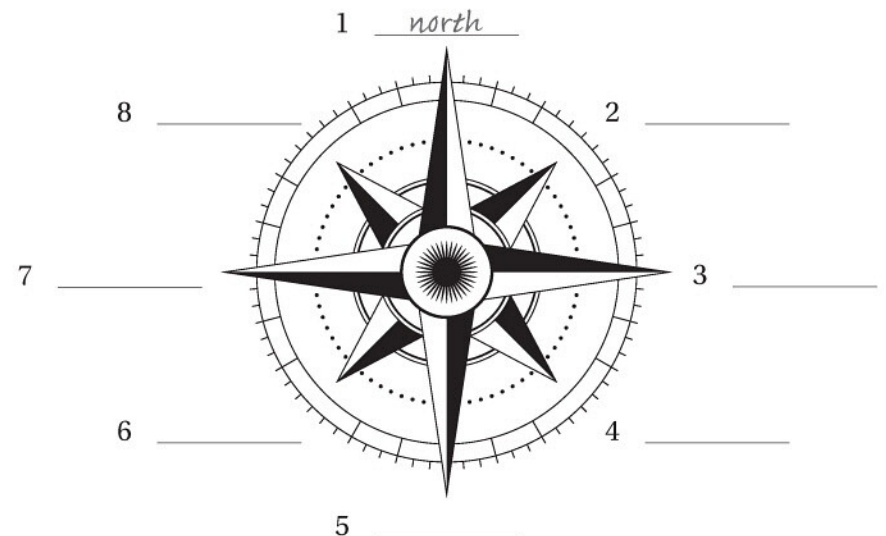

- ❖ Go for a walk in the Ka'u ⁴Desert / Lake (take plenty of water with you as it's very hot and dry there).
- ❖ Spend a day lying on the world famous ⁵waterfall / beach in Waikiki or learn to surf there.
- ❖ Trek through the beautiful Hawaiian ⁶lake / rainforest. Wear good walking boots and take a camera to photograph the birds and animals that live there.
- ❖ Visit Mauna Kea – the highest ⁷mountain / beach in Hawaii. You can drive to the top of Mauna Kea in about two hours and near the top you can visit ⁸Lake / Coast Waiau – but don't go into the water or drink it.
- ❖ Relax on a boat trip along the Wailua ⁹Mountain / River.
- ❖ Take a trip to the Waimea Falls Park on O'ahu. There you can swim in the pool underneath the fifteen-metre high ¹⁰waterfall / mountain.

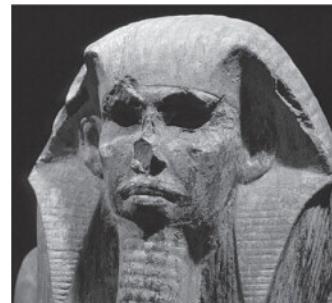
