### Facts and figures about Brazil

Brazil is the world's **a5th** largest country. It covers nearly a **b½** of South America, and the coast of Brazil is **c7,491 km** long! More than **d200,000,000** people live in Brazil and **e87%** of them live in towns and cities. The capital city is Brasília, which is home to around **f2,700,000** people. Brazil's main language is Portuguese, but Brazil became an independent country in **g1822**. People celebrate Independence Day on **h6th September**, which is a national holiday.

Brazil is a popular place for foreign tourists. According to the World Tourism Organization, the number of visitors in **i2012** was around **j5.7 million**. Many people go to Rio de Janeiro on the east coast. One of Rio's most famous sights is the statue, Cristo Redentor, which is **k30 m** high, at the top of the Corcovado mountain. You can walk to the statue, but be careful in summer when Rio's average temperature is between 25°C and **l30°C**!
