 - 2 2Some people argue that computers will start to do more and more for us in the home and at work. We have already seen examples of this with the invention of cleaning robots 3such as the Roomba, and smart devices which enable us to turn appliances on or off from a distance.
 - 3 4Others feel, however, that although computers may help us with our daily tasks, this will not necessarily mean that we have free time. They argue that employers may simply expect us to have time to do more work. 5In addition, wearable technology may mean that we are expected to be available to our employers at all times.
 - 4 ⁶Personally, I doubt that we will have more leisure time in the future. Back in the 1970s, it was predicted that more technology would mean that people in the future would have a five-day weekend. This has certainly not happened yet, and I don't expect it to happen in years to come.
 ⁷In fact, it seems that the more technology we invent, the harder we are expected to work and the more we are expected to produce.
